


Our history


- 1870 → Federico Fliedner comes from Kaiserswerth (Germany) to Spain after the recognition of religious freedom in the Spanish Constitution of 1869.
- His command: "helping Spanish protestant churches born in the second half of XIX century to grow up, giving them solid education and improving their organizational capacity, encouraging collaboration among protestants"
